Arid Gujarat

1. Farmers are advised to undertake irrigations for wheat at critical stages namely: jointing and booting stage, and second top dressing of N at booting stage or 50 days after sowing.
2. Farmers are advised to undertake irrigation and precautionary spray of Dimicron-100 (250ml)/Nuvacron (850ml) using 100 lit. water per hectare for aphid in mustard
3. Farmer should harvest mature castor capsules to avoid shattering problem.
4. The precautionary spray/dusting of sulphar should be done in cumin, when weather is cloudy.
5. Farmers are advised to start preparation of fields for summer groundnut in the region.
6. Now ber is on harvesting stage, it is advised to harvest the fruits at proper stage.
