

## Off campus and on campus input distribution and training programme under SCSP scheme by CAZRI, RRS, Jaisalmer

Off campus and on campus input distribution and training on improved cultivation of kharif crops were organized on 7<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>nd</sup> July 2022 by ICAR-CAZRI, RRS, Jaisalmer. A total of 25 farmers from Dewa village, 45 farmers from Kotri village and 30 farmers from Lanela village of Jaisalmer district were participated and benefited from this programme. At the onset, Dr. M. Patidar, Head, RRS, Jaisalmer welcomed the participant and briefed the ongoing activities of SCSP scheme at different villages. He also delivered lecture on agronomic practices of Kharif crops for enhancing crop productivity and income of the farmers. Dr. S.C. Meena discussed the problem of insect pest in Kharif crops at length and suggested the managements. Dr. Dileep Kumar Dangi emphasized on integrated farming system in arid region. Dr. Anil Patidar explained the importance of improved varieties and their cultivation practices for higher seed production. Dr. Saranya R. discussed the problem of disease in kharif crop and suggested the management. Inputs in form of seeds like 303 kg of Bajra (variety RHB-223), 400 kg of Guar (variety RGC-1033), 340 kg of Moong (variety IPM-205-7) and 100 kg of Moth (variety RMO-2251) were distributed to the farmers. They were very happy for getting improved seeds of different crops for utilization on their fields. They were also benefited from training programme and assured to adopt improved package of practice of different Kharif crops in their fields.
