

Three days Farmer's training program on vegetable cluster bean and sheep production

CAZRI-Regional Research Station Jaisalmer, organised three-day training program on vegetable cluster bean and sheep production in Biotech-KISAN Hub Project under DBT from October 10-12, 2024, at Chandan, RRS, Jaisalmer and Pokhran. Dr. R.S. Mehta, Head, RRS, Jaisalmer Dr. S.C. Meena, Dr. Anil Patidar, Dr. Shiran K., and Dr. Dileep Kumar were the coordinators of the programme. Dr. A.K. Shukla, Head RRS Pali and Principal Investigator of the project inaugurated the program. Dr. Sumant Vyas, Head, Division of Livestock Production and Range Management, CAZRI Jodhpur, interacted farmers about Health care and hygienic management of Sheep in western dry region. The training was attended by more than 175 of farmers from the villages of Chandan, Jaisalmer and Pokhran blocks who were provided with insights into sustainable and efficient farming techniques. In the training farmers were educated about good agricultural practices and modern agronomic practices, improved varieties, pest management, and agroforestry, with a particular emphasis on cluster bean production and multi nutrient blocks for animal feed were distributed to sheep rearing farmers. The program emphasized the importance of adopting scientific techniques for sustainable agriculture and livestock management, which can significantly enhance productivity in these challenging environments. The initiative is expected to contribute to the region's agricultural development, improving livelihoods and fostering innovation among local farmers.
